BE IT RESOLVED, that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education hereby appoints Corrinda Brigandi as a part-time Paraprofessional (5.75 hours), in the non-competitive class of the civil service, to serve a thirty (30) month probationary term commencing February 8, 2019, at an hourly rate of \$14.56 per hour for the 2018-2019 school year.
