BE IT RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, Board of Education hereby adopts the expenditure appropriation of \$64,443,174 (The Budget) to operate the schools for the 2020-2021 fiscal year and present such budget appropriation to district residents pursuant to Governor Cuomo's Executive Order 202.26, by an absentee ballot vote with ballots due to the District Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on June 9, 2020.

BE IT RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education hereby approves the 2020-2021 Property Tax Report Card as presented to the Board at this meeting; and, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Assistant Superintendent for Business is directed to submit the Property Tax Report Card to the State Education Department by the end of the next business day following this approval.

Mrs. Weiss moved and Mr. Tomeo seconded a motion to approve Item K.2 as presented the Board at this meeting.

3. Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a motion to approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Elwood Union Free School District advertised for the bid of Building and Site Improvements at John Glenn High School and James H. Boyd IS;

WHEREAS, the Elwood Union Free School District received bids for the Building and Site Improvements at John Glenn High School and James H. Boyd IS; on May 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the District's Architect and Administration have reviewed the bids submitted by the bidders in connection with the Building and Site Improvements at John Glenn High School and James H. Boyd IS contract; and

WHEREAS, based upon said review, Benchmark Construction Group, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder on Base Bid No. GC-1 (General Construction) and Laser Industries is the lowest responsible bidder on Base Bid No. GC-2 (Site Improvements) and Maccarone Plumbing is the lowest responsible bidder on Base Bid No. PC-1 (Plumbing) and Servewell Electric, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder for Base Bid No. 1 (Electrical) in

accordance with General Municipal Law section 103.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby awards the contract for the Building and Site Improvements at John Glenn High School and James H Boyd IS as follows:

- Base Bid No. GC-1 to Benchmark Construction Group, Inc.
- Base Bid No. GC-2 to Laser Industries, Inc.
- Base Bid No. PC-1 to Maccarone Plumbing
- Base Bid No. EC-1 to Servewell Electric, Inc.

in accordance with the bid specifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Elwood Union Free School District hereby authorizes the Board President to execute the necessary documents on behalf of the Board of Education

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Assistant Superintendent for Business is hereby authorized to approve change orders in the maximum amount of \$25,000 per change order for this project.

4. BE IT RESOLVED, that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education hereby appoints any school district clerical employee, upon the approval of the Assistant Superintendent for Business and the District Clerk, to serve as Election Inspectors for the processing of the June 9, 2020 School District Budget Vote and Election with no additional compensation.
