WHEREAS, the Elwood Union Free School District received bids for the Roof Replacements at Elwood Middle School and Harley Avenue PS; on July 9, 2018; and WHEREAS, the District's Architect and Administration have reviewed the bids submitted by the bidders in connection with the Roof Replacements at Elwood Middle School and Harley Avenue PS contract; and

WHEREAS, based upon said review, Icon Contracting Group, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder on Base Bid No. GC-1 (Elwood Middle School Roof) and BBR Contracting Corp. is the lowest responsible bidder on Base Bid No. GC-2 (Harley Avenue PS) in accordance with General Municipal Law section 103.
