D. REPORT FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS – Dr. William J. Swart

High school liaison, James Tomeo, gave his report.

Dr. Swart recommended the BOE adopt the proposed resolution and submit the proposed 2008-2009 budget to voters.

In the proposed budget, there is no provision for full day kindergarten.

I believe the 4.7% increase in next year's budget is the lowest recommended to this and any BOE in my career.

Projected average tax increase is less than 4.99%. That increase is comparable or less than most Western Suffolk County school districts.

We learned we will receive approximately \$570,000 more in state aid than previously anticipated. I recommend using the majority of these additional funds to reduce school taxes.

I want to thank our legislators and community members for their efforts to bring more state aid to Long Island.

I know that the legislature and legislators desire that all public school districts on the Island use increased state aid to reduce school taxes.

Clearly, this nation is in the midst of a recession. New York State, particularly Wall Street, is the poster child of our economic woe.

In this proposal, there is a recommended restoration of two elementary teaching positions that I previously recommended to abolish. The positions restored are in grade 2 and grade 5. In essence, I believe the funds in the recommended budget sustain reasonable class sizes at all grade levels.

However, there are staff reductions associated with the proposed budget: an elementary assistant principal position and three elementary teaching positions.

As many of you know, the enrollment at the elementary level of our District has decreased by 125 students over the past 31/2 years. Unfortunately, reduction of staff is required for prudent use of District resources.

There are funds in the budget to expand programmatic offerings at John Glenn High School. Those expansive programs were described in my presentation before the BOE last week, which is available at the back of the room.

I believe this is a balanced budget and a responsible budget in the present climate of dismal National and State economic news. I believe I am putting forth an appropriate budget recommendation.
