### E. BUDGET ADOPTION

Recommend the Board adopt the following proposed resolution to submit the 2013/2014 budget to the district voters:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Elwood Board of Education submit the proposed 2013/2014 budget to the district voters on May 21, 2013 in the amount of <u>\$57,035,292.00</u> and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education submit the proposed tax report card as required by Sections 1608,1716(7) and 2601-a(3) of the Education Law.

**NOTE:** This budget represents a 4.42% increase over the 2012-13 budget and a <u>\$2,414,267.00</u> increase in spending over the 2012-13 budget. The tax levy increase in dollars and percentage is \$42,078,321.00 or a 3.18 % increase over the 2012-13 tax levy (which is within Elwood's tax cap for 2013-14).

Mr. Ciccone moved and Mr. Gutekunst seconded a motion to approve the resolution to adopt the budget and submit the tax report card. The motion carried 5 ayes, 0 nays.
